(Specimens may be brought for examination, either loose or mounted on a Cambridge stub)
- (ii) View the Philips XL30 Field-emission gun SEM which is digital, using Windows.
- (iii) See the Hitachi 7100 TEM
- (iv) A general tour of the facility particularly featuring the
Cameca SX50 X-ray microprobe
Analytical SEM on Hitachi S2500
